• John: Thanks to Belinda, Monique, Kristine, Karen, Liz, Antony and Aryo for volunteering their time and equipment/props on the day

• What worked well?

- \$118 raised with the raffle
- Over 200 new signatures acquired for the Rockingham Railway Junction petition
- Beautiful presentation attracted passers-by
- Use of multiple strategies e.g. raffle, free potatoes, petition, newsletter, presentation...kept people interested and engaged

• Areas for improvement?

- Not enough volunteers made it harder to reach every patron that walked by
- No commencing cash float in till made it difficult when selling tickets
- Use of T-shirts with SPA logos would be eye-catching and create visual representation/ logo recognition (Simone to follow-up)
- People couldn't see sign properly
- More planning prior to event: SPA to create calendar of events
- More community grants to assist with SPA buying own equipment

- Likely to be hosted at Hamilton Hill Memorial Hall
- Issues for discussion:
 - Tidier house frontages, council could take money off rates to pay for verges?

- "Tidy Houses" project incentivises garden and frontage maintenance of homeowners
- Themes of meeting will include networking, advocacy, support and neighbourhood (Simone to forward details to SPA)
- Azelia Ley Homestead under-utilised
 - > Café could be established there
 - Encroaching on Historical Society territory?
- Town Fair could take place on Rockingham Road
- SPA meeting on 1st of December to focus on Town Hall Meeting

- Roads have recently been re-sealed
- Also liaising with Mikayla from Liberal Party
- Targeting upper house: Kate Doust
 - > Waiting for appointment with Labor MP Pierre Yang
 - > Attending Parliament House in late November

• Update from Neighbourhood Watch (Rosemarie)

- Extra lights have been installed on public property, including local car park
- Don't get packages delivered to residence if no-one will be there to collect them, as there has been recent package theft
- Cockburn Community Development Group (CCDG) Dinner
- Occurring on the 30th November 2020
- Submissions for 2020
- Establishment of a PR sub-committee
 - There have been recent concerns that the SPA is non-inclusive of First Nations people and their perspectives
 - Work needs to be done to repair the relationship between SPA and the local Elders/ Aboriginal Reference Group

- SPA's image in general needs to be refreshed- very little residents are aware of who SPA are and how they represent Spearwood residents
 - Could set up a "Get to Know the SPA" event so that residents can familiarise themselves with SPA's role
- St. Pat's Proposal for old St. Jerome's Church
 - Kristine liaised with Lyn Levy of St. Pat's; Lyn advised SPA is unlikely to hear back regarding the St. Jerome's development for the following 2 months
 - Kristine to liaise with Lyn regarding permission for SPA to do some clean-up and maintenance inside the building
 - Local artist interested in using space for art classes
